

Performance Company Policies

Performance Company members **ART IN MOTION** represent KCPA to the world; it is a testament to your talent of and dedication to the performing arts that you were chosen. We showcase the beauty and grace that is KCPA.

Company members:

1. Are chosen based on classroom performance, attitude and work ethic:
 - a. Junior Performance Company members must be in Ballet III or IV, Boys Class, Teen Ballet or Adult Ballet and Musical Theatre (elementary age) or Acting (middle school and older)
 - b. Senior Performance Company members must be in Ballet V or VI and Acting
2. Are fully committed:
 - a. Sports or other activities including performances outside KCPA do not interfere with classes or company rehearsals
 - b. Members must be available to rehearse Saturday mornings
 - c. Members must be available for both Major Productions
 - d. Members are expected for community performances throughout the year
 - e. Members must be available for KCPA fundraisers
 - f. Must attend summer dance & drama camps/intensives the ballet intensive is new (so not required this year) but highly recommended as we will be learning variations for the upcoming Spring Show students enrolled are more likely to be cast in a lead
 - g. Members must be available for performances
3. Company members must have family accounts in good standing.
4. A standard yearly fee, collected in November, covers general costs:
 - a. Junior company members - \$100
 - b. Senior company members - \$200
5. Are appropriately dressed:
 - a. New tights and performance-worthy shoes are required for performances
 - b. Costumes may be required for purchase
 - c. Help may be needed if costumes are to be sewn
6. Are responsible for arranging their own transportation and accommodations (if necessary) for all events
7. Company members represent KCPA and should act accordingly:
 - a. Be respectful of teachers, parents, company members, and all other dancers
 - b. Be respectful of your body - eat healthy & notify teachers of any injury or potential injury
 - c. Support and encourage one another as well as non-company members
